

# Employment Opportunity



POSITION(S): Firefighter/Paramedic

Applications are being accepted to fill one position and to establish an eligibility list for the classification of entry level Firefighter/Paramedic.

Date Open: Immediately

Date Closed: December 1, 2017

Salary:

Firefighter/Paramedic \$41,480 annually per MOU

General:

The South Metro Fire District is currently recruiting highly trained and motivated individuals who are interested in becoming a Firefighter/Paramedic with a fulltime, Fire and EMS organization. South Metro serves approximately 52 square miles with 3 fire stations; service area covers the City of Raymore, Lake Winnebago, and portions of unincorporated Cass County. The Fire District currently employs 42 career operations personnel, 5 Command Staff Officers and 2 civilian personnel.

Educations/Experience and Special Requirements:

- Must be 18 years of age at the time of hire
- Must possess or be able to obtain a State of Missouri Paramedic License
- State of Missouri Firefighter I & II is highly preferred but not required (Must be successfully completed within one year of hire date)
- High School Diploma or equivalent
- Must possess a valid Missouri State Driver's License (or able to obtain prior to job offer)
- Must have a current CPAT Certification by time of job offer

Selection Process:

All applicants must submit legible, clear, concise, and complete information regarding their qualifications for this position.

While not required to interview, all candidates will be required to provide proof of Missouri Paramedic Licensure (or National Registry) and their CPAT certification as a condition of employment. Paramedics with National Registry only must successfully complete reciprocity as a condition of employment.

Application Procedure:

Apply by submitting a letter of interest, application, and a resume. Those selected applicants selected will be scheduled for a Peer Interview and Paramedic Review Board. Upon completion of interviews an offer will be made and an eligibility list will be established from those interviewed. Being interviewed does not guarantee selection to the eligibility list, nor is the Fire District bound to hire from those interviewed if no candidate can be selected from those interviewed. Interviews will be scheduled around the week of December 4th—8th.

Paramedic Students:

Those currently in a paramedic program may apply; however, successfully obtaining paramedic licensure in Missouri must be completed before a job offer will be extended.
